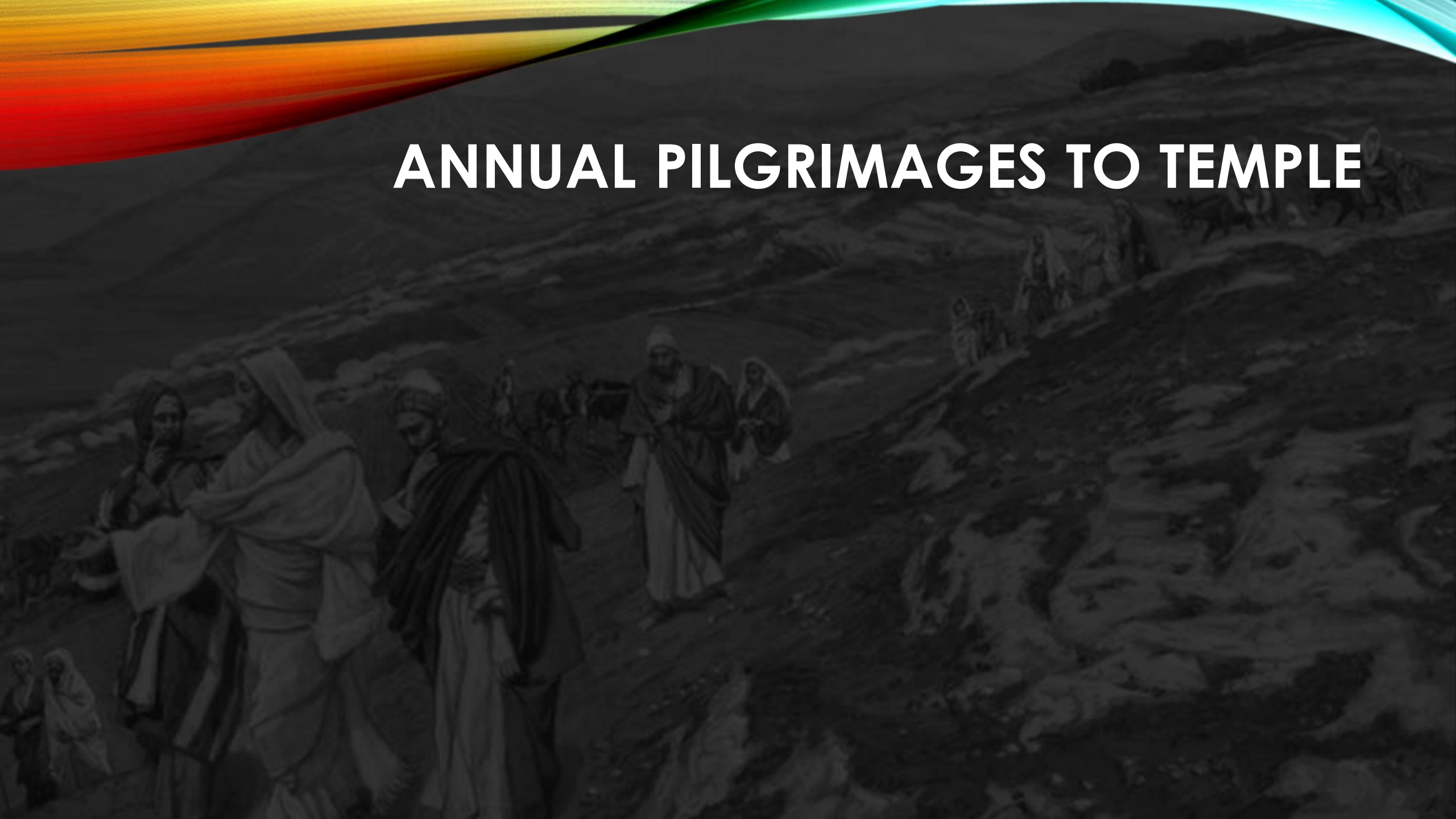


TEMPLE LIFE (Infancy)

The First Presentation in the Jerusalem Temple

- Every firstborn belonged to the Lord
- Parents had to pay 5 shekels to priest
- Mother must present herself at the temple for purification

ANNUAL PILGRIMAGES TO TEMPLE

- As was required (at least 3x year for major festivals) Deut. 16:16
- Jesus was no stranger to the pilgrimage journey
- At 12, first time he joined Joseph and participated in feast like other men

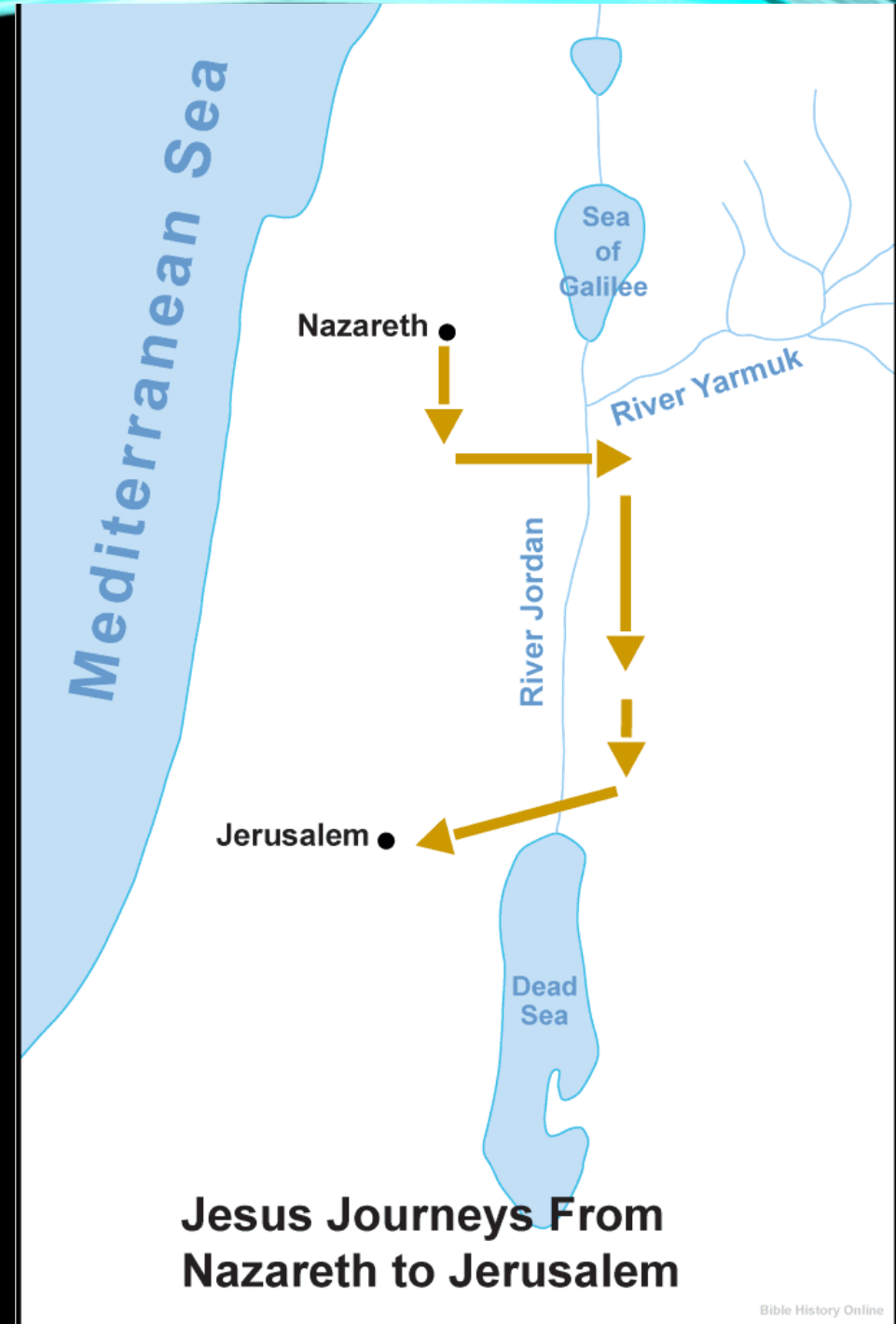
JESUS' OTHER TEMPLE INTERACTIONS

- John 2: Drove moneychangers out of “His Father’s House”
- John 3: Private talk with religious leader Nicodemus
 - (“For God so loved the world...”) (16)
- John 5: Attends feast and heals man by pool of Bethesda
- John 7: In Galilee
 - Secret meeting in the temple (“How does he know these things?”)
 - Conversation/teaching with Jewish leaders (“If anyone is thirsty, let him come to me and drink”)

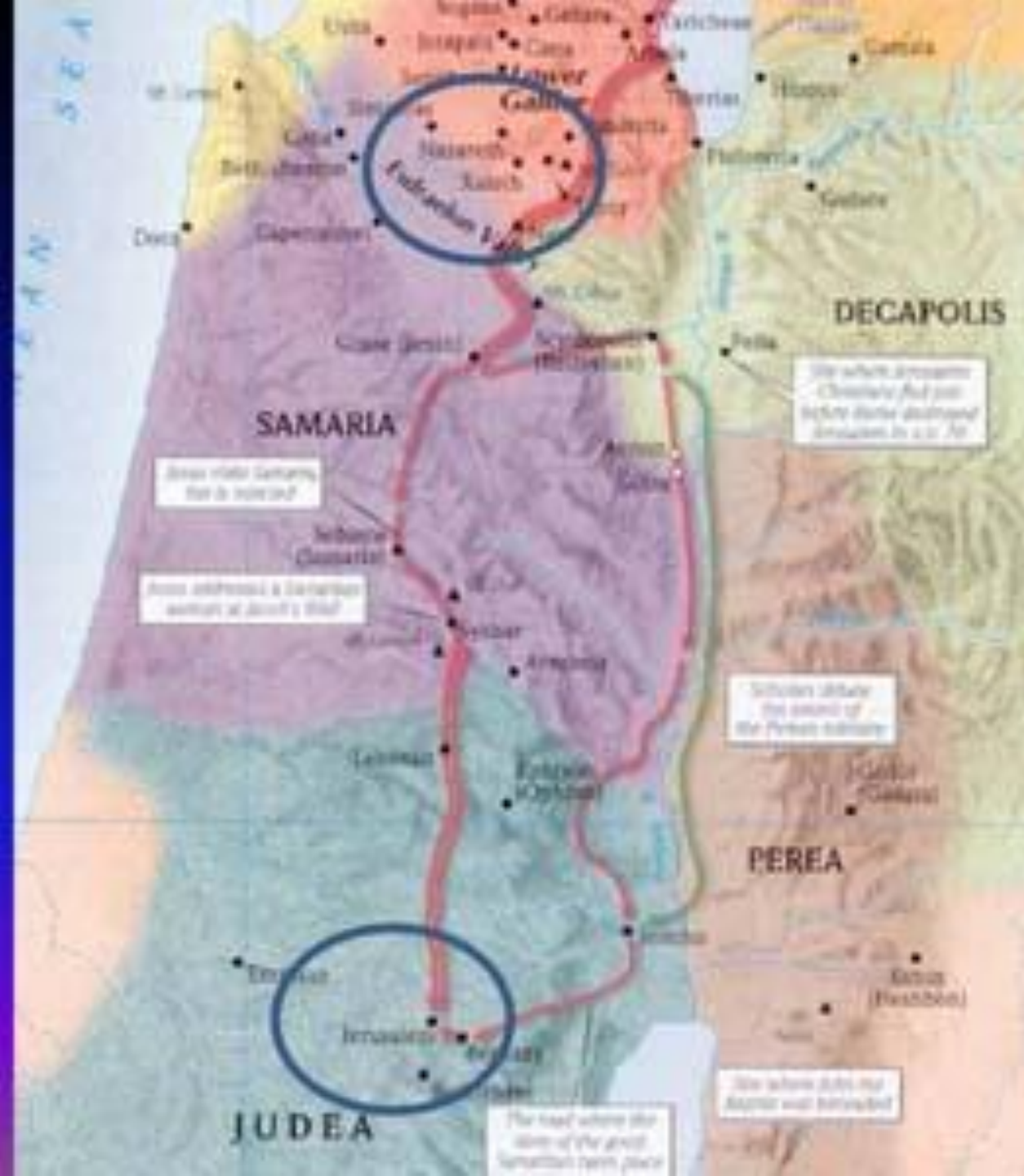
JESUS' OTHER TEMPLE INTERACTIONS

- John 8
 - Rescues woman taken in adultery
 - Claims to be light of the world (12)
 - Teaches the truth will set you free (32)
 - Claims eternality (58) ("Before Abraham, I was.")
- John 9: Heals man born blind
- John 10: Claims to be Good Shepherd and the Door
 - "I and the Father are one." (30)

PILGRIMAGE JOURNEY ROUTE TO THE TEMPLE



From Jerusalem to Nazareth through Samaria, the shortest route. 140 kilometers (85 miles). Flavius Josephus, first century Jewish historian, says the Galileans usually took this route on their trips to and from Jerusalem.



LUKE 2

- ⁴³ and when the feast was ended, as they were returning, the boy Jesus stayed behind in Jerusalem. His parents did not know it, ⁴⁴ but supposing him to be in the company they went a day's journey, and they sought him among their kinsfolk and acquaintances;

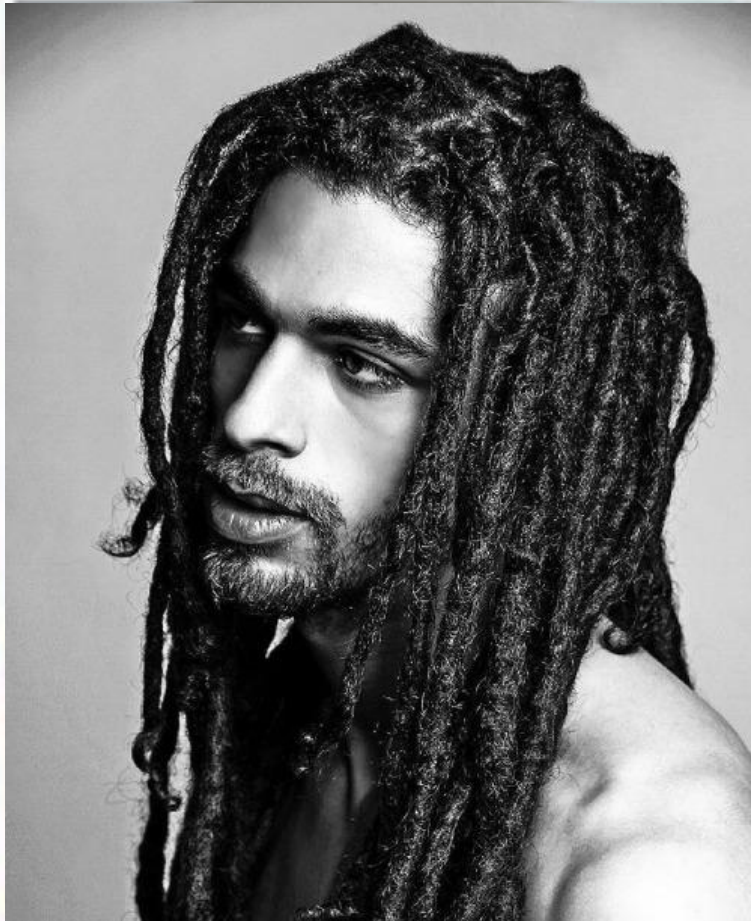


LUKE 2

- ⁴⁵ and when they did not find him, they returned to Jerusalem, seeking him.

- Jesus' earthly ministry

3 times

- Tempted in wilderness

3 times

- Prediction of Peter's denial

3 times

- Prayed in Gethsemane

3 days

- Time in the tomb

WHEN GOD DELAYS

- Some processes take time.
- God is still at work.
- God is where God needs to be.
- Delays strengthen faith.

SEVERAL WAYS TO GROW

- **In Physicality/Stature**
12 years old, chronological
- **In Wisdom**
Fear of God (awe, amazement, love, respect)
- **In Knowledge/Understanding**
Leaders were impressed by his understanding
- **In Sociability**
Treat people with kindness, respect, friendliness
